Facts about 60+ CAP

- The College Advantage Program (CAP) enables Pennsylvania residents ages 60 and older, to take college courses at Cal U tuition free.
- Classes may be taken to earn a degree or for personal enrichment.
- Classes may be taken for credit or may be audited. Audited courses are not assigned credit or a grade.
- 60+ CAP students may register for up to 18 credits per semester and up to 21 credits with special approval.
- If degree seeking, participants in 60+ CAP may earn an Associate's, Bachelor's, or Master's degree, upon successful completion of University requirements.
- Participants may take traditional or online courses.

Are there any costs?

- Participants are required to pay the university activity fees, application fee, and to purchase books and educational materials as required for courses.

How can I apply for the program?

- To apply online, log onto www.calu.edu/lifelonglearning and open the page link for 60+ CAP. Follow the links to complete the 60+ CAP application and the university application.
- To request an application, contact the office of Lifelong Learning.
- Pay the \$25 application fee.
- Submit a copy of your driver's license or birth certificate, as proof of your age.
- Have official transcripts sent from your high school or GED and all colleges and universities you have attended.
