**Peregrine Academic Services** - CALU will now accept the following 2 foundation courses for the MBA program from Peregrine:

- Foundations of Accounting (equivalent to ACC 200: Financial Accounting)

- Foundations of Microeconomics. (Equivalent to ECO 201: Principles of Microeconomics)

**\*\*ACC 200, ECO 100 or ECO 201 - Undergraduate Foundation Courses - These courses are only required if your admission decision letter listed the foundation courses in addition to the graduate courses in order to fulfill the graduation requirements of the program.**

Another option is to take CLEP tests: **Principles of Accounting (equivalent to ACC 200 - Financial Accounting);Microeconomics: equivalent to ECO 201 - Introduction to Microeconomics).**

**\* ECO 716 can be taken during the Winter 2 or Summer 3 term**

**\* FIN 711 can be taken during the Fall 2 or Summer 3 term**

**\* HRM 711 can be taken during the Fall 2 or Spring 3 term**

**\* MKT 711 can be taken during the Fall 2 or Spring 3 term**
