- A. Purpose & Scope:**
To describe the process and procedure for early admission of high school students
- B. Definition(s):**
- C. Policy:**
The University approves education opportunities for high-school students only under exceptional circumstances and only with the full cooperation of a student's high-school principal or school counselor. Students must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and have completed a standardized exam (PSAT, SAT or ACT).
- D. Procedure(s):**
Most frequently, students are permitted to take some university courses on part-time basis up to 30 credits, before graduation from high school.
