POLICY: Undecided Majors

A. Purpose & Scope:

Establish requirements for students who choose to declare a major of “Undecided Major”.

B. Definition(s):

Undecided Major – An academic major that does not lead to a bachelor’s or associate’s degree. These include General Studies in Liberal Arts (Major Code 5999), General Studies in Science & Technology (Major Code 7999), and General Studies in Education (Major Code 9999).

C. Policy:

- Students must declare a major that leads to a degree after earning 45 credits. Failure to do so will result in a registration hold which will not be lifted until the student has changed their major to one that leads to a degree.
- Transfer students who have more than 45 transfer credits may not enroll in the university as an undecided major.
- Students who have earned 45 credits or more may not change their major to an Undecided Major.
- Students who are in an undecided major will be given scheduling counsel by the Student Success Facilitators in Noss 210.
