I. Introduction

Logon banners provide a definitive warning that network intrusion is illegal and also warn authorized users of their obligations relating to acceptable use of the network.

Logon banners provide notice of the obligations and responsibilities relating to using the California University of Pennsylvania computer network. Thus, users of the computer network cannot claim ignorance of their actions.

II. Purpose:

The purpose of this standard is to require that a logon banner be displayed before a user accesses the California University of Pennsylvania computer network.

III. Standards

California University of Pennsylvania is to use logon banners for all systems and devices that are accessible from the network.

A. Banner:

“This is a California University of Pennsylvania system. Unauthorized access is prohibited. Access and use must comply with University Acceptable Use Policies and Procedures.”
